

Fuchen Teng's Biography:

Dr. Fuchen Teng is a Professor and the Deputy Chair of the Department of Civil and Construction Engineering at National Taiwan University of Science and Technology (NTUST) in Taipei, Taiwan. His research interests include innovative ground improvement, soil stress-strain-strength behaviors, soil–structure interaction problems, and the geological disposal of radioactive wastes.

Dr. Teng previously served as the Secretary-General of the Chinese Taipei Geotechnical Society (CTGS) between 2023–2025. He also held the position of Secretary-General for the AsRTC6 (Urban Geo-Engineering) of the International Society of Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering (ISSMGE). He currently serves as the Managing Editor for the Journal of GeoEngineering, an official publication of CTGS. Dr. Teng is also the co-author of the textbook, 'Fundamentals of Foundation Engineering,' published by Taylor & Francis.

Dr. Teng has been recognized with several paper awards, including the 2024 Paper Award in the Chinese Institute of Engineers (CIE), the 2023 Best Paper Award, and the 2020 Excellent Paper Award in the Journal of GeoEngineering.
